POSITION SUMMARY:

To bring awareness of biblical health principles to the membership of the Southern Union via its eight member conferences, as well as integrating with its departments through training, modeling, resourcing, and innovation, using the CREATION Health product/model.

SCOPE OF RESPONSIBILITY:

- Introduce and maintain the CREATION Health product as a wellness model to the Southern Union Conference staff. Collaborate with Adventist Health System (AHS) and Florida Hospital to develop a model that integrates with the current wellness model used by the Southern Union, retaining the exercise, financial incentive, reporting, and annual health check elements.
- Collaborate with Southern Union Departments to include the CREATION Health product as an added benefit to outreach. Special focus on the Publishing, Hispanic Ministries, and Ministerial departments. Produce materials in Spanish and other languages for the Magabook summer program and evangelism supplemental materials.
- Hold local training events such as pastors meetings, camp meetings, and weekend church events around the Southern Union territory.
- Continued collaboration with AHS to explore innovation possibilities to the CREATION Health product with the idea to make it easy for lay people of the Southern Union to access, teach, and provide to the communities they live in.
- Collaborate with the Education Department to find opportunities to teach the CREATION Health principles in our schools. Identify ways to adapt the material to be assimilated by elementary school aged children. Further study can be given to create a product for the teens as well, both for learning and possible summer income opportunities.
- Within the process of training, teaching, and innovation, find ways to showcase the health system/church
 collaboration. Highlight the fact that the church is working closely together with the "right hand of the Gospel."
- Maintain a connection with Andrews University Theological Seminary.
- Develop and maintain a Church-Hospital mission and ministry partnership with the Executive and Senior leadership
 of AHS.
- Engage faith-based communities, government/secular leaders, and divisions within the Seventh-day Adventist
 entities and organizations in developing a mutual beneficial partnership to deliver health education
 programs/seminars and ministry initiatives.
- Catalyst for a revolutionary relationship with AHS and its 30 Seventh-day Adventist hospitals.
- Other duties as assigned by the President.
